

Memorial Gift Policy

1. If the family (or friends) of a deceased fellowship member want to make a memorial gift in memory the deceased member, he or she is encouraged to consult with the Board on the suitability of the envisioned memorial. The Board will not participate in the fund raising or funding.
2. The family can offer funds or a material memorial to the Fellowship. The Board, considering the needs of the entire Fellowship, will decide whether to accept the funds or material memorial.
3. If Board accepts the memorial gift, the family will make a one-time donation of the funds or object to the Fellowship. When any such memorial is donated to the Fellowship, the Board will try to implement the wishes of the family, but the gift then belongs to the Fellowship, and the Board will use the gift in the interests of the Fellowship at the Board's discretion.
